

PEARL Research philosophy



- All we know about an environment arrives via our senses
- We process this information in parallel to create a perception of the environment
- We act on the basis of that perception
- The environment adapts according to our actions



The pathway from Environment to Neuron and back drives the design of the environment

PEARL creates environments ...



- Lighting simulate anywhere on the planet at any time
- Sound simulate 4D dynamic soundscapes
- Physical/touch simulate lifesize environments
- Smell simulate multiple and blended olfactory environments
- All at the same time

... then tests them with people



- So we can sense the responses:
 - Physically
 - Physiologically
 - Neurologically
 - Psychologically
 - Individually or in Groups
 - Interactions between people
 - Interactions between things
- To create human-centred design for people and planet

PEARL-CAVE tests environmental conditions



- Temperature/humidity
- Building-within-a-building
- Test interior spaces under different ventilation regimes
- Pathogen transmission and viability inside interior spaces
- Interior-exterior interactions
- Dynamic bus testing under different environmental conditions
