Testing and Structures Research Laboratory (TSRL)

Material testing lab widely used for industry, research and teaching

- Static, cyclic and high strain rate testing
- Imaging and thermography for deformation, strain and stress mapping
- Non-destructive testing
- Ultrasonic monitoring
- Composites manufacturing

Used by >150 researchers and students annually



Large Structures Testing Laboratory (LSTL)



Large hall for structure and sub-structure testing

- Realistic multi-axis loading
- Data-rich: imaging and sensor networks



Geomechanics Laboratory

Element testing and model testing of geomaterials

- Triaxial, oedometric, simple shear, hollow cylinder devices
- Temperature-controlled environment for gas hydrate generation and testing
- Staging for fieldwork: sensor development, calibration and field preparation
- Tank for ROV-based seabed testing

Used by >150 students for teaching and research projects annually




Geotechnical Centrifuge



Accelerated model testing of geomaterials via high gravity environment

- 6m-diameter, 130g acceleration
- 1 day test = up to 40 years
- Robotic multi-axis actuation
- Whole life simulation of loading and environmental forcing


